KC: 1-8-1ATS last 10 games (covered last one)

KC: 5-12-1ATS last 18 games vs. NFC South

KC: 1-8ATS last 9 games on natural grass

KC: 4 of last 6 vs. NFC- Under

TB: 4-1ATS last 5 games

TB: 4-0ATS as an underdog

TB: 5-1ATS last 6 games vs. AFC West

TB: 4-0ATS after having less than 90 rushing yards in previous game

TB: 5-0ATS after allowing less than 90 rushing yards in previous game

TB: 5-2SU last 7 vs. AFC teams

TB: 4 of last 6 games at Raymond James Stadium- Under

H2H: TB 5-1ATS last 6 meetings (5-1SU)

H2H: TB 4-1ATS last 5 meetings at Raymond James Stadium

H2H: Underdog is 4-1ATS last 5 meetings

H2H: Home team is 4-1ATS last 5 meetings

Picks: SU- TB 31-24 / ATS- TB / OU- Under
